About cookies

Sweden Rock uses cookies on its website. A cookie is a small text file sent from our server to your browser. Different cookies are therefore on different computers when you use different computers to access our site.

There are two types of cookies, one type is called session cookie, and the other is called permanent cookie. A session cookie is sent between your computer and our server in order for the websites to function properly during your visit. A session cookie is not stored on your computer, but disappears when you close your browser. A permanent cookie on the other hand is stored on your computer and allows, for example, our website to recognize your computer's IP address and therefore your web browser the next time you log in.
